

To note that Mr. Robert Lamothe has been appointed Indian Agent, Grade 3, for the Timiskaming Agency, Notre Dame du Nord, Quebec, and that he reported for duty on June 16, 1944, replacing Mr. Joseph Morin, who has been separated from the Service with effect from June 16, 1944.

He will receive salary at the rate of \$1380. per annum, plus house, fuel and light, valued at \$300. per annum. The house at the present time is not habitable and repairs are to be made, and as Mr. Lamothe will not be living in the house, it may be necessary to pay him cash in lieu of house, fuel and light for a few weeks. When he moves into the house, you will be advised and this matter adjusted.

While a Certificate has been issued for him in the name of "Robert Lamothe", it is noted that his signature is "J. Robert Lamothe". All communications to him should be addressed:-
