In accordance with your request of August 19 I am forwarding herewith in duplicate copy of report of August 27 by Mr. T.H. Boyd covering his relocation of the domestic water supply pipeline around Lots D and E. The proposed relocation was staked out on the ground.

The estimated cost of this work amounts to \$346.00, which is probably high as it was felt that excavation to grade might be expensive in that locality.

Probably it might be possible to salvage a certain amount of pipe, but it is doubtful if this would be economical as the system has been in a number of years and the pipe has, no doubt, deteriorated to a considerable extent.
