This aircraft was inspected by the writer on the day following the accident, and it was noticed that the machine was fitted dual controls. Our records show that the two pilots of the aircraft at the time of the accident had licences endorsed for D.H.82. Structural damages were observed on fuselage, tail unit, both upper main planes, and undercarriage. The propeller was also broken,
