

NOTE.

Farmers and others are invited to send specimens of cutworms, or of other insects, which are found causing injuries to their crops. Such specimens should be enclosed with a supply of food plant or grass in a tin or wooden box (not a paper box). Small packages up to 12 ounces in weight may be mailed "Free" as third class matter if addressed to the Dominion Entomologist, Department of Agriculture, Ottawa. In all cases the specimens should bear the address of the sender, and should be accompanied by a letter giving the crops which are being attacked and the extent of the damage.
