

TOMBS OF JOHN WESLEY AND ADAM CLARKE.

IN the Graveyard in the rear of City Road Chapel, John Wesley is buried. He was standing one day watching some workmen repairing the Chapel when he remarked to a lady by his side: "I should like to be buried just here amongst my workers;" and his wish has been gratified, for he is interred in the midst of about five thousand of his preachers and parishioners.

The low grave by the side of the Wesley Monument is that of the Rev. Dr. Adam Clarke, the Commentator. In Wesley's Tomb, ten bodies are buried; in the other, Dr. and Mrs. Clarke and their son.
