of the Paris Church, the Convention was photographed in a body.

The work of the Board will continue as during last year viz.:--

- 1. The support of the Misses Melville, including a share of the station expenses.
 - 2. The scholarship in Miss Macallum's school for "Galene."
- 3. The contribution of \$600 to the C.C.M.S., and of \$15 to the Congregationalist.
 - 4. The continuance of the Monthly Leaflet.

In addition, resolutions were adopted, (1) appointing a committee to enquire into the possibilities of work in the Klondike; and (2) urging upon the women of the Board, especially in rural districts, the necessity of themselves keeping up Church services by reading sermons or conducting Bible readings, when there is no settled pastor or appointed leader.

Invitations for the meeting of 1899 were received from Winnipeg, Embro and Ottawa; that from Ottawa was accepted.
