A Bill for appointing Firewards in the Towns of Fredericton and Saint Andrews, ascertaining their power and duty, and more effectually to prevent Fires in the said Towns.

A Bill in addition to and in amendment of an Act, intituled "An Act for the establishment, regulation and improvement of the Great Roads of Com-

munication throughout the Province."

A Bill to appropriate a part of the public Revenue for the purposes therein mentioned.

After which His Honor was pleased to make the following Speech to both Houses:

"Gentlemen of the Council, and "Gentlemen of the Assembly,

"The business before you being now finished, it is not necessary longer to detain you from your private affairs; and, in closing the Session, I have only to express my hope that the measures which have been adopted to provide for the public exigencies may be crowned with complete success."

And afterwards the Honorable Chief Justice Bliss by His Honor's command, said,

"Gentlemen of the Council, and Gentlemen of the Assembly,

"It is His Honor the PRESIDENT'S will and pleasure that the General As"sembly be prorogued to the third Tuesday in June next, and this General As"sembly is accordingly prorogued to the third Tuesday in June next, to be
"then here holden."
