USURY LAWS :

1. Bill to repeal Chap. 58 of Consol. Stat. of Canada, intituled "An Act respecting-Interest," (M. Thibaudeau); Presented, 35. Referred; The 3 following Bills also referred, 217. Report first Bill with amendments, 222. House goes into committee thereon; Report progress; Ordered to sit again forthwith; Speaker resumes the chair at the hour of adjournment, 229. Motion that the Order of the Day for committee on the Bill be read; Amendment to insert the word "not" negatived; Main motion agreed to; Bill considered and amended; Reported; Re-printed, 255. Read a third time; Amendments moved, 278. Negatived; Further amendment moved and carried; Motion that the Bill, as amended, do pass; Amendment to add "this day three months" carried, 280 to 285.
2. Bill to amend the laws relative to Usury, and to establish a maximum rate of interest (Mr. McMicken); Presented, 36. Referred to committee on the foregoing Bill, 217. See *supra*, 1.
3. Bill to amend 22 Vic., c. 82, and to prevent Usury, by fixing the rate of Interest at six per centum per annum (Mr. Bourassa); Presented, 40. Referred to committee on the first of the above Bills, 217. See *supra*, 1.

5. Motion, that with a view to the effectual promotion of agriculture, commerce and manufactures, it is expedient to fix a maximum rate of Interest for the loaning of money; Consideration postponed, 50. Order discharged, 353.
6. Motion to appoint a Select Committee to inquire into the working of Cap. 58, Consol. Stat. of Canada, respecting Interest, 188. Agreed to on a division, 216.
