and its Dependencies, &c.*

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING :

**W**HEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands Pro-  
rogued until THURSDAY the TWENTIETH day of AUGUST, in-  
stant: and whereas I think fit to Prorogue the said GENERAL ASSEM-  
BLY until THURSDAY the FIFTEENTH day of OCTOBER next ensuing :  
I do therefore, by this my Proclamation, further Prorogue the  
said GENERAL ASSEMBLY until THURSDAY, the FIFTEENTH day of Oc-  
TOBER next, as aforesaid: of which all Persons concerned are  
required and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves  
accordingly.

Given under my Hand and the Great Seal  
of the said Island of Newfoundland, at  
the Government House, at St. John's,  
in the said Island, this Eighteenth day  
of August, One Thousand Eight Hun-  
dred and Sixty-three, and in the  
Twenty-seventh Year of Her Majesty's  
Reign.
