PROPOSED CUT IN C. N. R. FREIGHT RATES ON LUMBER

Ottawa, May 22—Replying to questions from New Brunswick members C. A. Hayes, vice-president of the Canadian National Railway, this morning informed the special House committee on railway transportation costs that the C. N. R. proposed a cut of 16 or 17 p. c. in the freight rates on lumber.

President Beatty of the C. P. R. giving evidence on Friday, suggested a cut of 11.70 p. c.

COMPENSATION ASSESSMENTS MUCH REDUCED

In the report of the Workmen's Compensation Board for last year there is a remarkable showing of proposed reductions of assessments of employers of labor under the readjustments made possible by the large surplus. The report says that the total assessments made upon employers in 1921 amounted to \$1,092,267.58. It was found upon making adjustments of the 1920 payrolls that they greatly exceeded the estimated surplus of \$237,131.02 shown in the report for 1920 actually turned out to be \$538,011.29 or an increase of over \$300,000.00. This increase together with the good accident experience in 1921 required a retroactive adjustment in the rates for 1921. It will result in a reduction of \$305,000 on the assessments for 1921. That amount will be credited to the employers in the various industries which are entitled to a reduced rate

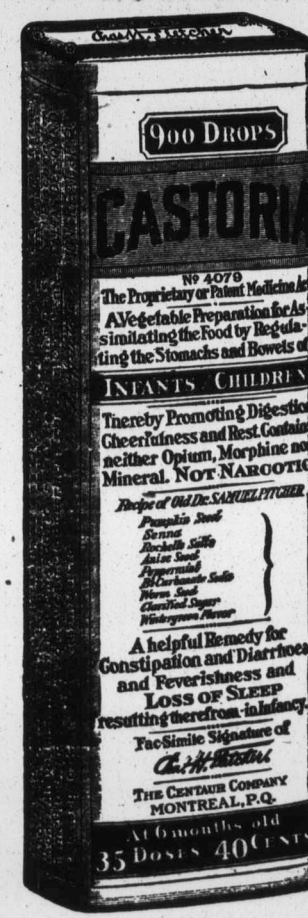
COM. CHARLES SOWTON
