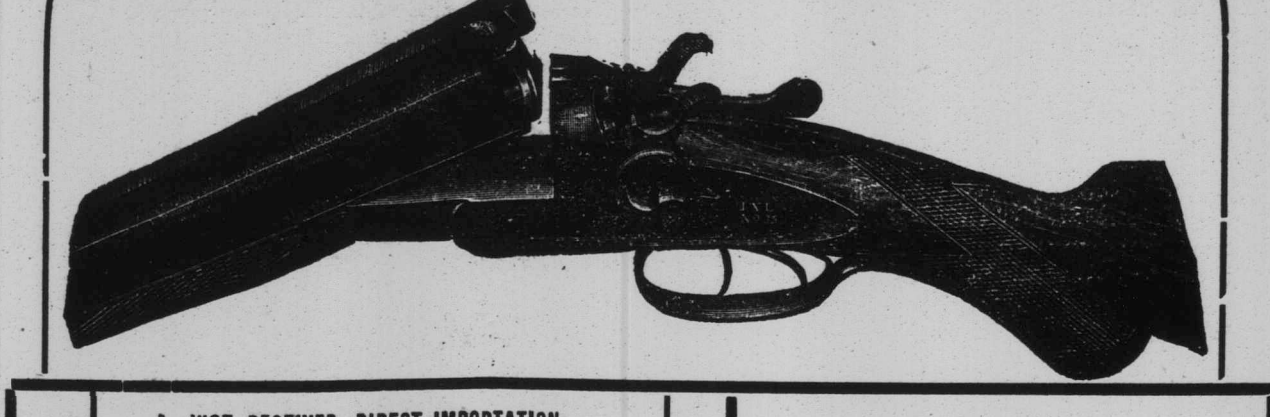
LAI TO REST.
