UNMARRIED BUT "MRS." Problem of World War's Near-Widows Partly Solved.

Berlin, August 12.—One curious piece of war legislation is reported from Baden, where the reigning grand duke has authorized the ministry of jusice to permit unmarried women to assume and legally wear the prefix "Mrs." if they can prove a bonafide engagement to marry a participant in the war, and if the prospective bridgroom has been killed or has disappeared as a result of the war.

Baden is considered to have done original pioneer work in solving the difficult problem of the world's war near widows.
