Special Cold Germ Yet Found

CHICAGO, Nov. 1.—(By Canadian Press.)—Dr. John F. Norton and Dr. J. Jordan of the department of hygiene and bacteriology of the University of Chicago, have begun an investigation into the cause of colds. They have sent about 2,000 questionnaires to students, concerning their general conditions, weight of underwear and other points bearing upon colds. No single germ ever has been found to be the cause of colds. Dr. Norton said, adding that while numerous germs have been found to be contributory causes, no single one has been found to be dominant.
