Mr. Samuel Stevely and Party in New York City.

The Syracuse Post-Standard says: Samuel Stevely, former mayor of London, Ont., and elected to the Mystique Krewe in Syracuse in the same class with Supreme Court Justice Hughes, then governor, came to Syracuse yesterday, bound home from the Shriners' convention.

Silk American flags and the Union Jack of Canada flutter side by side on the hood of Mr. Stevely's machine, while the crest of the secret order adorns the windshield. Pennants from Niagara Falls insignia of Mocha banners from Rochester and any number of souvenir flags add to the symphony of color.

"It was the most marvelous spectacle I ever witnessed," said Mr. Stevely in commenting on the review of the patrols of the day before on the meadows of one of Rochester's parks. More than seventy patrols participated, producing a gorgeous rainbow effect. Such a scene, has probably never been equaled.

Mr. Stevely is accompanied by his wife and H. E. Buttry, also a Shriner. He expects to return to Syracuse in the fall for the carnival of the Mystique Krewe.
