

COPPER STOCKS FEATURE STREET

Forty-Seven Individual Issues Make New Peak Prices.

New York, Dec. 26.—Copper prices advanced today, with 47 individual issues making new peak prices. The advance was due to a combination of factors, including a report of a new discovery in the West, and a general upward movement in the market.

The advance was most marked in the case of the Anaconda Copper Co., which advanced 1/2 cent to 15 1/2 cents. Other issues making new peaks included the Canadian Copper Co., which advanced 1/4 cent to 12 1/4 cents, and the Copper Range Co., which advanced 1/4 cent to 11 1/4 cents.

The advance was also reflected in the price of copper metal, which advanced 1/4 cent to 15 1/4 cents. The price of copper wire also advanced, with the No. 10 wire advancing 1/4 cent to 11 1/4 cents.

PRINTING DEPT. IS A BOON TO TECH.

More Than 5,000 Pieces Have
Been Turned Out Since
Classes Opened.

The printing department of the Technical High School, which opened last September, has already begun to pay its way.

The department has printed more than 5,000 pieces, covering fourteen different jobs, used in the Tech.

The next big job the department is to do for the school is the printing of 2,000 copies of the annual school announcements, the publication of which has previously cost the school in the neighborhood of \$200.

Early in the new year the department will commence work of various educational offices and committees, and the paper and other material is being bought for use in the department.

While the prices on a contract basis are not as high as those on a piecework basis, the work thereby getting practice in the profession.

All the boys attending the school take the printing course, and during their first two years at the school, they have learned sufficient of the trade to be able to take on a contract basis, or to whether they wish to specialize in it or not by taking a third year at the work.

Instruction is given in hand setting, all kinds of printing, binding and setting of advertisements, and the next step is the installation of a computer in the department.

The cost of the machines themselves, approximately \$3,500 each, makes their installation prohibitive.

The actual cost of the work turned out by the department thus far for the school printing, totaled \$135.82. The price for the same amount of printing would have cost the school over \$315.

The department, which is under the direction of Matthew Smith, printer, was opened in September with equipment costing \$10,000.
