Nonforfeiture Privilege.

As soon as a policy has acquired a cash surrender value, default in payment of premiums does not lapse it, so long as such value is sufficient out of which advance premiums. Thus if five premiums have been paid, and the sixth falls due and is in default, the Company will, without request, continue the policy in force, by charging the premium against it as a loan. This method is repeated at each subsequent default, until the cash surrender value is exhausted, and by this means the full value of the policy is used in maintaining it in force. The policy continues meanwhile upon the original plan which it was issued, and if a participating one, continues to share in the profits of the Company. The accumulated loans may be resumed at any time, or before the time when the cash value has been fully used up, without submitting evidence of health, as the policy will not lapse until its full value has been applied to pay premiums.
