Colin of Sanachan, and three daughters. He died on the 6th of July, 1646, and was succeeded by his eldest son, John Molach.

II. John Molach, second of Applecross, married a daughter of Hugh Fraser of Belladrum, with issue: Alexander, Roderick, Kenneth, Iain Og, and five daughters. Iain Og was one of the four heroic Johns killed at the battle of Sheriffmuir in 1715.

III. Alexander, third of Applecross, was lieutenant-colonel of the 1st Mackenzie Regiment at Sheriffmuir in 1715. He married Ann Fraser, by whom he had Roderick, Kenneth, Colin, and five daughters. He was deprived of his estate for joining in the Rebellion of 1715.

IV. Roderick, eldest son of Alexander, purchased, in 1724, the estate of Applecross from the Court of Enquiry for £3,550. He married Ann Macdonell, by whom he had John, Alexander, Kenneth, Mary, Ann, and another daughter. He was succeeded by his eldest son, John. Mary, his eldest daughter, was married to John Mackenzie of Highfield, and had a son named Thomas.

V. John, fifth of Applecross, had no issue. With utter indifference to his father's family,
