

*Inhumane Weapons Convention*

(Convention on Prohibitions or Restrictions on the Use of Certain Conventional Weapons Which May Be Deemed to Be Excessively Injurious or to Have Indiscriminate Effects.)

Signed: 10 April 1981.

Ratified: not yet ratified by Canada.

*Convention on Early Notification of a Nuclear Accident*

Signed: 26 September 1986, Vienna.

Ratified: 19 January 1990.

Entered into force for Canada: 18 February 1990.

*Convention on Assistance in the Case of a Nuclear Accident or Radiological Emergency*

Signed: 26 September 1986, Vienna.

Ratified: not yet ratified by Canada.

*Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material*

(Intended to ensure the physical protection of nuclear material in domestic storage and transport.)

Signed: 22 September 1980.

Ratified: 21 March 1986.

Entered into force for Canada: 8 February 1987.

*The Antarctic Treaty*

(Guarantees the use of Antarctica for peaceful purposes only and prohibits any activities of a military nature, nuclear explosions and the disposal of radioactive waste material.)

Done at Washington: 1 December 1959.

Entered into force: 23 June 1961.

Acceded: 4 May 1988.

Entered into force for Canada: 4 May 1988.

*Protocol to the Antarctic Treaty*

Signed by Canada: 7 October 1991
