- atroad se studied, that pilot projects be undertaken and timanced and that such activities, where successful, be extended.
- (24) That additional funds be provided to commission outside writing of information material.

Establishment and Staffing

- (25) That the establishment of the new Press Office be: 1 FSC 7, 1 FSO 5, 1 FSO 4, 1 AO (?) and supporting staff.
- (10) As part of this establishment, that a position be regarded to secure the services of a non-rotational press officer with specialized experience in press arrangements who would be primarily concerned with V.I.P. visits.
- (27) That the Press Office should be so staffed as to be able to provide all its services in both French and English and that the Head of the Office be bilingual.
- (28) That at most posts abroad information work continue to be performed by EAO's or FSO's.
