

2. Paragraph 1 does not apply to the enforcement of the express provisions of a binding instrument between the Parties or their governmental entities.

3. The Parties do not waive claims related to intellectual property.

ARTICLE 11

Existing Rights, Obligations and Commitments

This Agreement shall not affect the rights and obligations of a Party resulting from other international agreements to which it is party. Where the Parties wish for this Agreement to apply to a non-legally binding arrangement between them, they shall refer to this Agreement in that arrangement.

ARTICLE 12

Dispute Settlement

1. The Parties shall endeavour, in good faith, to resolve any dispute between them arising from the interpretation or implementation of this Agreement amicably, through diplomatic consultations. Consultations shall take place as soon as reasonably practicable under the circumstances.

2. If a dispute arising from the implementation of this Agreement cannot be resolved through consultations within a reasonable time, the Parties will refer such dispute to a jointly accepted dispute settlement mechanism.
