PRAYERS.

Mr. Gray, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, pursuant to Standing Order 60(1), laid before the House,—Notice of Ways and Means Motion to amend the Income Tax Act.—Sessional Paper No. 1/308.

Mr. Gray,—pursuant to Standing Order 60(1), laid before the House,—Notice of Ways and Means Motion to amend the Customs Tariff and Excise Tax Act.—Sessional Paper No. 1/309.

By unanimous consent, it was ordered,—That the said Ways and Means notices be printed as appendices to this day's *Votes and Proceedings* and *Hansard*.

Pursuant to Standing Order 60(2), Mr. Macdonald, a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, designated Orders of the Day for the consideration of Ways and Means motions.

By unanimous consent, Mr. Macdonald (Rosedale), seconded by Mr. Olson, moved,—That the Standing Committee on Broadcasting, Films and Assistance to the Arts be empowered to consider and make a final report to the House, not later than December 5th, 1969, upon the legislative framework, organization, and operations of the Company of Young Canadians, and that, for the purpose of its inquiry, the Committee be empowered to retain the services of counsel and to adjourn from place to place within Canada, and that the clerk, counsel, and the necessary supporting staff be authorized to accompany the Committee.

After debate thereon, the question being put on the said motion, it was agreed to.
