NOTICE OF MOTION.

For Monday, 18th May, 1868.

By the Hon. Mr. *Wilmot* :—

1868.

May 16.—That an humble address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General, praying that His Excellency will be pleased to direct that copies of all documents and surveys relative to the construction of a Canal connecting the waters of the Gulf of St. Lawrence, with those of the Bay of Fundy, may be procured from the local Governments of *Nova Scotia* and *New Brunswick*, and submitted to the Commissioner of the Board of Works for his report thereon, to be laid before Parliament at its next Session.
