WOUND, *n.* 1st. Made by an iron acuminated tool, Stúuds.

2d. By gun-shot, or arrows, Silip.

3d. By a whip, Stiz's.

4th. An injury, hurt, Stgup.

5th. The wounds all around the body of our Lord, S'chitlze.

6th. The wound, hole in his hand, Stgochinéchs. In both hands, Stgotgochinéchs.

7th. The wound in his foot, Stgoshin. In both feet, Stgotgoshin.

8th. The wound in his side, Stgotniut.

NOTE.—All these words refer only to the person wounded, and not to the one who inflicts the wound.
