

Trustees neglecting to attend meetings, in certain cases, vacate their office.

In cases of vacation, Lt. Governor may appoint other Trustees.

Persons under thirteen years of age may not drive any carriage upon these roads, under fine of 10s.

Persons in charge of teams may not walk at any distance, so as not to have the perfect command of his horses.

And any person hindering or interrupting any of Her Majesty's subjects in any way upon said roads, subject to fine and imprisonment, and may be apprehended by any person seeing the offence committed without any warrant.

aforesaid, That if any of the present Trustees shall neglect to attend three successive meetings of the Commission, after due notice of such meetings shall have been personally served upon such Trustees, unless they shall have been prevented by sickness or absence from the District, he or they shall be deemed or taken to have vacated their office of Trustee, and upon a representation of such absence being made to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or person administering the Government, by a majority of the Trustees, it shall and may be the duty of the said Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or person administering the Government, to nominate and appoint another or other Trustee or Trustees in the place of such Trustee or Trustees neglecting to attend as *aforesaid*.

46. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid*, That no cart or wagon travelling on any of the Turnpike roads shall be driven by any person who shall not be of the full age of thirteen years, under a penalty not exceeding ten shillings, to be paid by the owner of such cart or wagon; and if the driver of any carriage whatsoever on any part of the Turnpike roads shall, by negligence or wilful misbehaviour, cause any hurt or damage to any person or carriage passing or being upon such road, or shall quit the road and walk on the foot-path, or wilfully be at such distance from such carriage, or in such a situation whilst it shall be passing upon such Turnpike road that he cannot have the direction or government of the horses or cattle drawing the same, or if any person shall, by negligence or misbehaviour, prevent, hinder or interrupt the free passage of any carriage, or of Her Majesty's subjects, on any of the Turnpike roads, every such driver so offending in any of the cases *aforesaid*, and being convicted of any such offence either by his own confession, the view of a Justice of the Peace, or by the oath of one or more credible witness or witnesses before any Justice of the Peace for the District, shall for every such offence
