

# RETURNED SOLDIERS

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## WELCOME AND AID LEAGUES

A Saskatchewan Committee of the Dominion Hospital Commission has been appointed with head office in Regina, to organize "Returned Soldiers' Welcome and Aid Leagues" throughout Saskatchewan. This Committee and the local "Leagues" will undertake to find suitable employment for soldiers returned to Saskatchewan. Facilities in Saskatchewan for the training and treatment of returned soldiers have been reported to the Dominion Hospitals Commission.

## FACILITIES FOR TRAINING

Facilities for Training include: (a) Teaching; (b) Commercial Life; (c) Agricultural Pursuits; (d) Industrial Pursuits. There are Collegiate Institutes and Normal Schools at various centres throughout the Province, and a fully equipped College of Agriculture at Saskatoon.

## FACILITIES FOR TREATMENT

Facilities for treatment include: (a) Mental Disorders; (b) Pulmonary Diseases. St. Chad's (Anglican) College has been placed at the disposal of the Commission for use as a Military Hospital.
