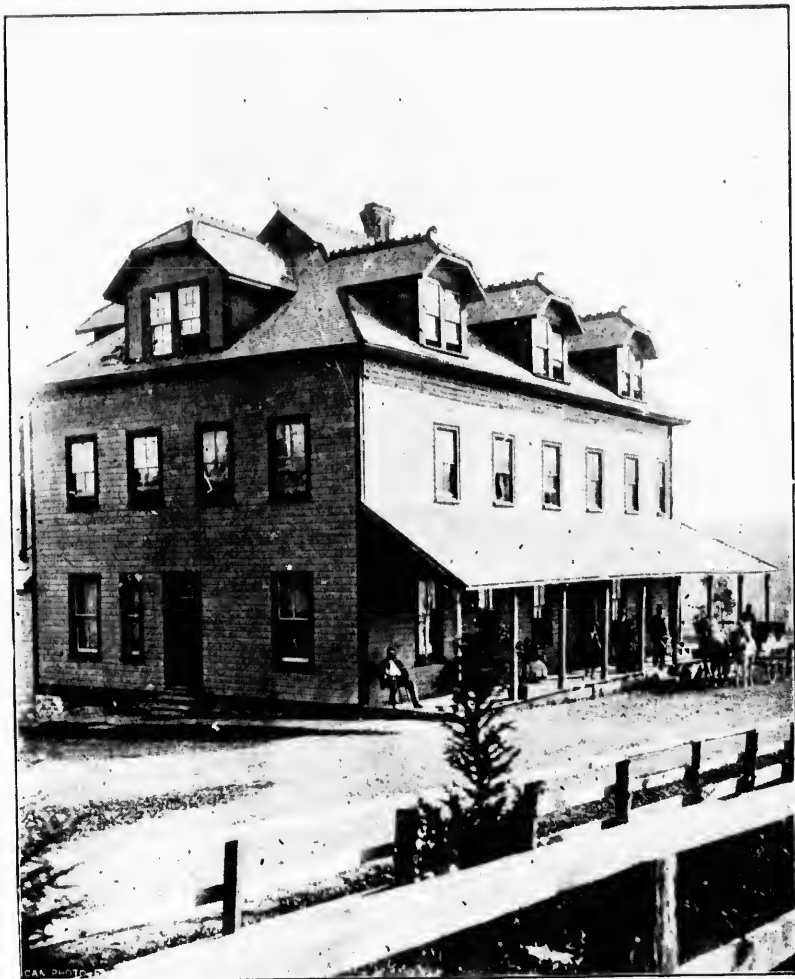


The chief railway point for this region is Peterborough, 90 miles from Toronto, 30 miles from Port Hope, 36 miles from Belleville.

Connection is made at Peterborough by G. T. R. for Lakefield, 9 miles distant, the terminus of one of the Midland divisions of the G. T. R. and the gateway to the Kawartha waters.

Lakefield is a pretty village of nearly 1,500 inhabitants and has good stores, electric light and comfortable hotels, the principal house being the Queen's.

There is a very good steamboat service from Lakefield by the "Sunbeam" which meets passengers on the evening train from Toronto,
