

Real Citizens' Committee Issues Strong Circular

Many Arguments Against Double Tracking Advanced By Nearly Forty Prominent North Toronto Residents.

The following circular has been received by some prominent citizens, who are opposed to binding the town further to the Metropolitan Railway...

Dear Sir: We take the liberty of addressing you in regard to the proposed double-track by-law...

1. It will make it impossible for the citizens of North Toronto to travel from the southern portion of Toronto for a single fare on Yonge street to the northern limits of the town...

2. It will make it necessary to build a special road-bed upon Yonge-street and to keep this road-bed in repair...

3. At such a time as this when so many railway projects are developing it is unwise to commit the town to an agreement for all time...

4. The offer of the Metropolitan Company, including cheaper fares and 500 per mile for one track, is quite insufficient...

5. It is not, in our opinion, the best bargain that may be made with the Metropolitan Company...

6. The cost of double-tracking is not only an expense connected with the proposition, but it is a big amount...

7. It would be well for the common everyday ratepayer to ask himself as to the source of the funds for forcing a double-track on the town...
