An Extension Tax. The report of the Committee on Consti-tutions and Laws was again taken up, and peveral amendments to the constitution were the first \$1000. The court adjourned until 2 o'clock.

At a former session the per capita tax was bolished. If was now proposed to estab-hish an extension-of-the-order tax, rated as follows: For those carrying \$500 or \$1000, five cents per month; \$2000, ten cents per month; \$3000, 15 cents; \$4000, 20 cents; \$5000, 25 cents. The Supreme Chief discus-sed this proposed change, and gave an ex-planation of the reason and purpose of this tax. If extension work is to be actively prosecuted a fund must be provided. If the fund were provided all deputies would be kept in the field, and perhaps others added. The inspector of insurance had vetoed any further draft upon other funds of the order for this-purpose. This new tax was in hen of the capitation tax, and it also cov-ered the cost of publication of The Indepen-ter.
