THE SENATE PASSED BILLS.

Lord Minto Attended the Red Chamber for a Short Time Yesterday Afternoon.

LIEUT.-COL. WHITE'S DISMISSAL. Was Criticized by Sir Mackenzie Bowell-Hon. David Mills Replied—Bills Sanctioned.

Ottawa, May 7 (Special).—This afternoon in the Senate His Excellency the Governor-General attended, and, amid the gaze of the Commissioners, assented to general bills, among other things the supplementary supply bill for the Ottawa vote.

Sir Mackenzie Bowell opened up the question of Lieut.-Col. White's dismissal from the staff course for political reasons, and strongly criticized the Minister of Militia's action.

In reply to structures upon Dr. Borden, Hon. Mr. Mills said: "No major-general except Sir Selby Smith had got on well with the Ministers of Militia. Differences of opinion were of common occurrence. They had parliamentary government, and had a Minister responsible for every act done by an official, military or otherwise. The Opposition should remember this and not unfairly criticize the action of the Minister of Militia, for he needed all their support. He thought Sir Mackenzie had pressed unduly against the Minister, where the Minister had acted properly."
