From the Treasurer's Report it will be seen that there has been a decrease in the expenditure of \$448.61, while, at the same time, we have paid for insurance \$234, which will not occur again for

The Managers, in view of the probable revenue three years. and the obligations of the current year, are of opinion that the stipend of the Pastor should be increased by \$500 per annum, and it is hoped the congregation will concur in this recommendation.

At the last Annual Meeting a motion was passed recommending a reduction in the church debt, and leaving the matter in the hands of the Session and

Managers to take immediate action.

In pursuance of this, early in the year, a joint meeting of the Session and Managers was held, and a committee appointed to solicit subscriptions from the congregation. This committee have, so far, obtained subscriptions amounting to \$10,960, of which \$5,430 has been paid, the balance pay-There has also been able in one or two years. paid on the original subscription list \$582, making Of the \$8,000, which at our last in all \$6,012.
