Students taking Practical Work in this Department are required to provide themselves with necessary apparatus (apart from furnaces, balances, &c.) Students of the Second Year must be provided with a set of Blowpipe Apparatus and a Book on Blowpipe Practice, and will be required to pay a Laboratory Fee of \$1.00. Students of the Third Year must provide themselves (in addition to the apparatus of the Second Year) with a Book on Determinative Mineralogy, and will pay a Laboratory Fee of \$2.00 for minerals, reagents, &c. Students of the Fourth Year will pay a Laboratory Fee of \$4.00 for assay materials, and use of instruments generally.
