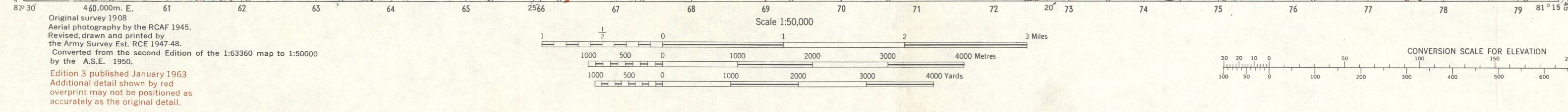
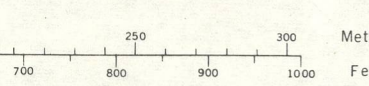
POINT	SCHOOL	FOR STANDARD MILITARY GRID REFERENCE

North	Take South edge of square in which point lies, and read the figure printed opposite this line on East or West margin or on the line itself on the face of the map.	Estimate west (Westward)
