

Sir Ernest MacMillan was born in Mimico, Ontario. He conducted the Toronto Symphony for 25 years, and headed such organizations as the Toronto Mendelsson Choir (conductor), Faculty of Music at the University of Toronto (Dean), Royal Conservatory of Music (Principal), CAPAC, Canadian Music Council, Canadian Music Centre, Canada Council (founding Chairman), among others
