Certified copy of a Report of the Committee of the Privy Council, approved by His Excellency the Governor General on the 2nd October, 1911.

The Minister of the Interior submits, under date 1st September, 1911, that the Department of Indian Affairs has requested that two parcels of land comprised in Township 29, Range 1, East of the Principal Meridian, and Township 28, Range 1, West of the Principal Meridian, be set apart for the purposes of the Fisher River Band of Indians.

The Minister states that he is of the opinion that the application should receive favourable consideration, and recommends that the land applied for be set aside for the above purpose, and that the control of the same be transferred from the Department of the Interior to the Department of Indian Affairs.

The Minister observes that the land referred to may be more particularly described as follows:-

Composed of FIRSTLY: all that portion of township twenty-nine in the First Range East of the Principal Meridian, which may be more particularly described as follows.

Commencing at the intersection of the northern limit of Indian Reserve No.44 with the line between Lots numbered One hundred and One and One hundred and Two of the said Reserve; thence northerly on a production of the said line a distance of forty chains; thence easterly and at right angles to the last course a distance of forty chains; thence southerly and at right angles to the last course a distance of forty chains more or less to the northeast corner of Lot numbered One hundred and Nine of the said Reserve; thence Westerly following the northern limit of the said Reserve a distance of forty chains more or less to the place of commencement, containing by admeasurement One hundred and sixty acres more or less, and

SECONDLY: all that portion of township twenty-eight in the first range west of the Principal Meridian, which may be more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of section fifteen of the said Township, thence northerly following the east boundary of said section fifteen and the east boundary of the south-east quarter of section twenty-two of the said township, to the north-east corner of the said south-east quarter of said section twenty-two; thence westerly following the north boundary of the south halves of sections twenty-two and twenty-one to the north-west corner of the south-west quarter of said section twenty-one; thence southerly following the west boundary of the south-west quarter of said section
