## GENERAL MEETINGS.

- 15.—An Annual General Meeting of the members and friends of the Society shall be holden in St. John's on the second Thursday after Trinity Sunday, or as soon after as the Bishop may appoint. The Secretary shall give notice to each of the Clergymen in St. John's, who shall publish it [with the Bishop's consent] in his Church on the previous Sunday.
- 16.—At the Annual General Meeting a report on the state of the Society, with the Treasurer's accounts, duly audited, shall be submitted by the Committee, to be printed, or otherwise, as shall be then and there determined by the members.
- 17.—A special general meeting may be convened at any time,
  [1] by the President; [2] by a Vice-President and six members
  of the Committee, or [3] by any twelve members of the Society
  whose payments are not in arrear; provided notice of such
  meeting be duly given as in the case of annual general meetings.
- 18.—The Chairman shall not vote at any general meeting, except in the case of an equality of votes.

## COLLECTIONS.

- 19.—It is expected that a collection for the various objects of the Society will be made every year by every Clergyman in the Diocese, from every head of a family and every adult member of the Church in his Mission, assisted if need be by his Churchwardens and other respectable members of his congregation.
- 20.—Every Clergyman shall transmit to the Secretary a list of the contributors to the objects of the Society in his Mission,
