"It is an elementary proposition that supply and demand in the world market fix the price," declared one of the departmental heads. "Any Canadian can get these dairy products if he pays what other people are prepared to pay. People who would limit exports and fix prices on these commodities would resort to a procedure regarding their own products or salaries. The Government does encourage export trade because building it up in the only way in which we can hope to pay the war debt."

**HAMILTON DEALERS IN BACON  
SAY THEY LOSE.**

Testifying before Lieut.-Col. Morison the Hamilton representative of the Board of Commerce, retail dealers in Hamilton said that the price of bacon had fallen considerably during the past six months. They said they could not give the profit on bacon. W. J. Hobson of the Peebles-Hobson Co. said that for some time his firm was losing about 4 cents a pound on what it sold.

Harry Pearson said the price of select bacon was now 42 cents a pound, as compared with 46 cents in October. He stated that "English" bacon was 51 cents a pound, and explained to Lieut.-Col. Morison that "English" bacon was not imported, but called "English" because of the English process of curing being used. Lieut.-Col. Morison said the retail dealer was allowed a profit of 26 per cent. over the gross wholesale cost. J. L. Lewis, Editor of The Herald, declined to disclose the names of the dealers quoted in interviews published in The Herald when the order fixing bacon profits was issued. Later in the evening W. J. Hobson told Lieut.-Col. Morison that he was one of those interviewed. He had said that he would welcome an order fixing the profits at 20 per cent.
