

other County or Electoral Division, either as being included therein by name, or according to the boundaries established for the same; and any place mentioned in this Act as constituting a Parish, Township or Village, shall, with its usually acknowledged and known limits, be reputed to be a Parish, Township or Village, for all the purposes of this Act, notwithstanding that such place may not have been, under the authority of the law, theretofore erected, proclaimed, acknowledged or incorporated as such.

Union of a Town with a County not to affect qualification of Electors in the Town.

VIII. And be it enacted, That the provision of this Act uniting any Town in Lower Canada with any County or Counties therein, as an Electoral Division, shall not be understood to alter the qualification of Electors in such Town; but notwithstanding such Union, every person who, without this Act would, either as a Proprietor or as a Tenant, be entitled to vote at the Election of a Member to represent such Town in the Legislative Assembly, shall, under this Act, be entitled to vote at any Election of a Member to represent the Electoral Division formed by the union of such Town with any County or Counties.

IX. Provided always, and be it enacted, That the Act of the Legislature of the late Province of Lower Canada, passed in the ninth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, and intituled, *An Act to make a new and more convenient subdivision of the Province into Counties, for the purpose of effecting a more equal Representation thereof in the Assembly* than heretofore; and so much of the Act passed in the Session held in the fourteenth and fifteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, *An Act to make certain alterations in the Territorial Divisions of Upper Canada*, or of any other Act or Law in force in this Province, or in any part thereof, as may be inconsistent with this Act, shall be superseded and repealed from the time this Act shall come into force and effect.

Commencement of Act.

X. And be it enacted, That this Act shall have force and effect from and after the end of the present Provincial Parliament, and not before.
