An Act to incorporate the Kettle River Valley Railway Company.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented praying that it be Preamble. enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House. 5 of Commons of Canada, declares and enacts as follows:—

- 1. Lloyd A. Mauly and Hugh S. Cayley, both of the city Incorporaof Grand Forks, and William T. Smith of the city of Greention.

 such persons as become shareholders in the company, are
 10 hereby incorporated under the name of "The Kettle River Corporate
 Valley Railway Company," hereinafter called "the Company." name.
 - 2. The undertaking of the Company is hereby declared to Declaratory. be a work for the general advantage of Canada.
- 3. The persons named in section 1 of this Act are hereby Provisional 15 constituted provisional directors of the Company.
- 4. The capital stock of the Company shall be three million Capital dollars, and may be called up by the directors from time to stock. time as they deem necessary, but no one call shall exceed [twenty per cent on the shares subscribed, not shall a greater 20 amount than fifty per cent of the amount subscribed be called up in any one year.]
- 5. The head office of the Company shall be in the city of Head office. Grand Forks, or such other place in the Province of British Columbia as the Company from time to time determines by by-25 law.
 - 6. The annual meeting of the shareholders shall be held on Annual the second Wednesday in September in each year.
- 7. At such meeting the subscribers for the capital stock Election of assembled, who have paid all calls due on their shares, shall 30 choose five persons to be directors of the Company, one or

more of whom may be paid directors.

2. The majority of the board of directors, including the Majority to president, shall at all times be British subjects and resident in subjects.
