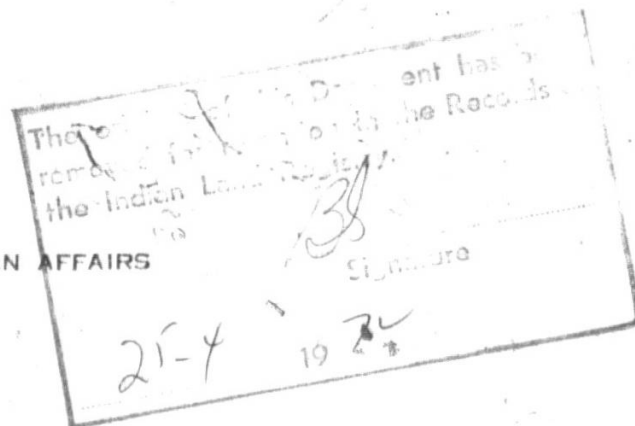

Kendall property 65 acres within city limits.

Situated on Old St. Peter's Road, now privately owned.

Mr. Kendall should provide right of way from his property to Alexander St. otherwise Department would have to purchase same from other owners.

Mr. Kendall asks \$6000.00. Mr. Robertson in report of 6th June, 1923 advises paying not more than \$4800.00 unless higher valuation made by a disinterested party.

Mr. Robertson also recommended that a vote of all the Indians should be taken as to their willingness to go to Kendall property after explaining to them that city water and sewerage will not be obtainable. ✓

Memo Nov. 12th, 1924, states it has been decided to purchase about 20 acres of Dr. Kendall's property. No mention made of right of way.

No independent valuation of this property on record apart from Mr. Robertson's figure which covered entire 65 acres.

No mention is made of disposition of present reserve, or of Dr. Kendall accepting same in payment for property he desires to sell.
