Nichole, Rector St. John's Church, Chapleau, Ontario, conducted the service. Flying resumed 1330 hours. LAC Hardy, J.C. ground looped Harvard 2755 while doing solo formation, uninjured, C-2 crash, damage to starboard wing, wing tip, aileron oleo leg and airscrew, due to error in judgment while landing cross wind. Night flying carried out.	✓
	14-7-41		Accident to Harvard 3155, pilot LAC Merrett, J.I. uninjured C-2 crash while practicing night flying sequences 7 and 8, CAV-U. Party of 100 R.M.C. Cadets in charge of Lt/Col. Campbell and Lt. Keardon visited the station and were conducted on a tour by Wing Commander D.A.R. Bradshaw. Major General Hertzburg, Commandant R.M.C. visited Station Headquarters. S/Ldr. H.J. 	18-7-41		Average flying day slight wind drifting clouds in morning, overcast in afternoon with light showers and strong wind. Flying washed out at 1500 hours.	
	19-7-41		Strong west wind 8 to 30 m.p.h. during morning, heavy clouds with some breaks. Flying washed out 1000 hours. Dual only in afternoon. No night flying.
