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It was intimated to me sometime ago that there is a connection, and I am inclined to believe it. At least I would not deny this possibility with proper investigation. If this connection does not exist there would be no harm done. But if it does, and by all appearances they have been already, knowingly or unknowingly, been serving the cause of the Third International, it may be more important and more harmful and will be able to assist the communistic cause more than even the present Soviet economic system will be able to do. As I said, these are fields that I would not overlook to investigate if the means were provided.

While the Third International with its headquarters in Moscow is generally regarded the centre of the whole system and independent in itself, representing the highest instance of the organization, I regard it only as a unit, in itself complete, but not independent. In my estimation it is used by another body, secret and unnoticeable in general investigation, as a whip against nations as and when this secret body finds it necessary. This conception of mine is not imagination, though you will find very little of it known and still less said. It is subject to investigation, though it might prove difficult, dangerous and expensive to do it. It would be in my estimation worth while for your government to tackle it.

But what we know is that a 160,000,000 nation is sacrificed today by a group of fanatics, who will not stop before anything in order to reach their aim--that is world revolution. Millions of dollars are spent yearly for that purpose. The youth is trained. Monster factories are built to break the world market system, and we have felt the first slight move of it already. What is done to prevent it, to fight against it?

It is said that a sick body can easily fall a prey to germs and that as long as the body is kept well and healthy the danger is negligent. But is our body on the North American Continent and in Western Europe still healthy enough to resist the germs of communism? If we want to be honest we can not say it in face of the existing and still increasing unemployment that it is all well.

It is quite recommendable to keep up the optimism with repeating "Cheer-up" campaigns in the press for the ones who do not see or know any more. Let them go the quiet old way. But the ones who see the approaching danger will find no excuse for not acting. There is no time and no room left for long systematic anti-communistic campaigns. The time for quick and drastic action against this approaching economic, social and religious danger is now. If it is prepared properly there will be no reason to feel alarmed about it and the general public may be saved the uneasiness it would bring. If known, the approaching danger can be fought and eliminated very successfully without much publicity. It is necessary to protect your own country, but this would not be fighting the danger and eliminating it. The place to do it is Russia. It must be done only by Russians and in that event even an approaching war could be avoided. No foreign country should have its hands in it. But they can help financially. It will take less than the U.S. A. business men have on their books now against the Soviets, and there will be more hope of getting it back than there is at present of ever getting it from the Soviets, unless you swamp your own markets with their goods, produced by slave labour, which in addition would put the U.S.A. at the mercy of the Soviets.

If your Honour is interested to know how it can be done in order to assist the cause, or knows of men in the U.S.A. who are convinced enemies of communism and prepared to prove it with action, I would be only too glad to communicate again.

As I have sent the copy of your report No. 2290 to the Headquarters of the Anticommunistic Russian movement in France, to whom I am sending also a copy of this letter, I would appreciate very much the receipt of another copy from you for my further use here.
