I have to inform you that Mr. McKenha,
The pector of Roman Catholic Indian Schools, has reported that the Indians of Sandy Bay have asked that the Department let their children who attend the Sandy Bay Boarding School home on Saturdays to spend the day and return in the evenings. The Department understands that you are willing to accede to their request and it may be granted on the distinct understanding that any pupils who abuse this privilege shall have it stopped. The Department would like you to report after it has been tried for say a month on how it works.
