I beg to inform you that a request was recently made by the church authorities for an increase in the pupilage at the St. Mary's Mission Boarding School. Mr. Inspector Cairns, who made a recent visit to this school, reports that they have ample room to accommodate seventy-five pupils. The Department has, therefore, decided to grant an increase of fifteen pupils at this school and will from the first instant pay the grant for the pupils enrolled up to the number of seventy-five at \$100.00 per capita. You will be good enough to inform the Principal of this school accordingly.
