Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 7th, instant, I regret to say that the Department is unable to purchase any seed wheat as the supply, which the Ontario Government Agriculture Department expected to have for sale, has been delayed in shipment. If you can secure the wheat you require, namely, 32 bushels, locally, you may do so.

You may also purchase some seed oats, but, I will depend on you to supply seed, only, to those Indians who have their land prepared.

A supply of forms is being sent under separate cover. One of these should be signed by each Indian obtaining seed. The signed forms should be carefully kept by you, in order that you may make the necessary collections, in the fall.
