First administrative act of new department was preparation of Regulations for National Registration. (P.C. 3156, July 12/40)

Registration itself carried out in three days - Aug. 19, 20 and 21.

Duplicate cards prepared at once for single men and childless widowers from age of 19 to 45, for purpose of compulsory mobilization for training.

Cost of Registration greatly reduced by tremendous amount of voluntary unpaid assistance.

Voluntary assistance from organizations and individuals in publicity contributed largely to success.
