LONDON,
had fulfilled our undertakings up to the hilt but urged
that if acceleration were possible effect on French morale
would be considerable.

It was explained that the contribution already promised represented absolute limit of what we could do.

Monsieur Daladier observed that the scale of equipment of the British Forces appeared to exceed considerably that of the French Forces and suggested that if a less generous scale were adopted the numbers of British Forces could be substantially increased.

In reply it was stated that on the whole our own scale was not appreciably more generous than that of the French but that the question would be examined. Ends.
