THE ACCUSED WAS CAUTIONED AS FOLLOWS:

"Do you wish to make any statement or to give evidence on oath? You are not obliged to say any—thing or give evidence unless you wish to do so, but whatever you say, or any evidence you give will be taken down in writing and may be given in evidence."

THE ACCUSED DECLINES TO MAKE A STATEMENT OR TO GIVE EVIDENCE ON OATH AND RESERVES HIS DEFENCE.

THE ACCUSED DOES NOT CALL ANY WITNESSES FOR THE DEFENCE.
