Ry-Laws.

I.—That there shall be a regular Lodge at the Freemasons' Hall, New Malton, at Seven o'clock in the evening, on the first and third Tuesday in each month, from the first day of October to the thirty-first day of March; and at Seven o'clock in the evening on the first Tuesday in each month, from the thirty-first day of March to the first day of October. The W. Master shall have power to call a Lodge in case of emergency.

II.—Every Brother shall appear properly clothed during Lodge hours, and shall preserve strict silence and decorum.

III.—Every Brother shall rise when he addresses the W. Master in the Lodge, and no Brother shall address him without having first openly asked his permission, or in due course, under a penalty of sixpence for each offence.

IV.—If any Member come to or appear in the Lodge in a state of intoxication, he shall forfeit 2s. 6d.; and if the offence be repeated thrice, he shall be liable to exclusion, and his conduct reported to the Grand Lodge.

V.—Whoever shall reveal the business of the Lodge, except it be to a Member, shall, upon
