Then the remains were borne up the broad stone steps to the Chapel where all that was mortal of the saintly Foundress lay until the last solemn Requiem was chanted at 10.30 on the morrow. The last solemn procession was formed of all her spiritual children present, to the little cemetery on the grounds where she rests to await the final call. The following lines by one of her saintly daughters, Sr. M. Ignatia Downey, since deceased, record the feelings of the Religious for their departed Mother:

IN LOVING MEMORY OF REV. MOTHER TERESA DEASE, Superior General OF THE INSTITUTE OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN IN AMERICA, WHO DIED AT LORETTO ABBEY, TORONTO, JULY 1st, 1889.
