

STATUTE OF FRAUDS.

The statute of Frauds in the three Provinces is substantially the same, only that, in *New Brunswick* and *Nova Scotia*, its provisions have been specially re-enacted, whereas in *Ontario* only one or two sections have been particularly re-enacted; the remainder coming under the general terms of the Act introducing the Law of England relating to Property and Civil Rights.
